



Babe Ruth Calgary Volunteer Policy

Our league is dependent on the valuable and vital efforts of our volunteers. Without our volunteers, the league could not operate. Therefore, each family (parents and/or other family members) are expected to volunteer on a rotational basis with other families on their athlete's team.

The specific volunteer duties required for each game include, but are not limited to:

- Scoreboard operator
- Scorekeeping (both Paper and Pointstreak)
- Game announcing

These different responsibilities are assigned based on your team's "home or away" status, but both teams require volunteers for each and every game.

In addition to game volunteer requirements, we also require volunteers for miscellaneous activities throughout the season. Some examples are (but not limited to):

- Evaluation Desk Volunteers
- Field Clean up and Pre-season Field Prep
- Casino Volunteers
- Etc.

If your player participates with Babe Ruth Calgary Baseball, there is an expectation that parents/players/family members will actively volunteer for a minimum of 10 events. Each game would be considered an event, field clean up would be considered an event, etc. etc. Your volunteer activities are tracked by your team's Team Administrator, so keep them informed and up to date.
